**COURSE SYLLABUS**

**Course Description:** Grades 11, 12 (1 semester)

This one semester course focuses on the experiences, skills, and responsibilities students need to form healthy, mature and successful relationships in their adult lives. Students will also read literature on ways to give and receive love in order to enhance all of their current and future relationships.

characteristics; explain how personality is related to self-concept, temperament, and human needs; analyze attitudes

toward sex roles and stereotypes; use the decision-making process to make and evaluate decisions; demonstrate

effective speaking and listening skills; and much more!
